WNY institutions of higher learning

WHO MAY APPLY:

High school students from Erie and Niagara Counties who anticipate acceptance in an A.B.E.T www.abet.org certified engineering or technology program at WNY institutions of higher learning.

AWARD:

Four (4) total scholarships awarded each year to matriculated Engineering or Technology students, \$300 per semester – Total \$2400. Recipients must be matriculated the fall semester following graduation from high school. The award is based on scholastic record, financial need, extracurricular activities, and leadership potential.

APPLICATION:

The 2023 scholarship application shall be completed by the applicant. Scholarship applications may be downloaded from our website at www.tesb.org. Older revisions of the application will not be accepted.

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QUALIFICATIONS FOR THE 2023 SCHOLARSHIP

To receive this scholarship, the successful applicant must meet and comply with the following:

1. The applicant must be a resident of either Erie or Niagara County in the State of New York and be graduated from high school in either of these two counties.
2. Applicants must be accepted in a WNY area university, college, or other institution beginning with the fall semester of their first year following high school graduation. The winner must be matriculated in an A.B.E.T www.abet.org accredited engineering/technology program requiring either two or four years (four or eight semesters) for completion leading to a degree in engineering or technology.
3. Winners will be selected by the Directors of The Engineering Society of Buffalo, Inc. (ESB) who will be guided by the recommendations of the Scholarship Committee. The Committee will base its recommendations upon the applicant's past scholastic record, financial need, leadership ability, and potential.
4. The winners shall continue with their four-year program without interruption to receive the full amount of the scholarship. However, if after the first semester circumstances should make it impossible for the student to continue their attendance without interruption, the Directors of The ESB may consider easing this regulation in order the spirit of the award be continued. The ESB reserves the right to cancel the scholarship if in any semester the recipient is registered for less than 12 hours of work, if the recipient is not pursuing course work toward a degree in engineering/technology or if the recipient is on academic probation for two consecutive semesters.
5. Students attending community colleges (such as the A.S. in Engineering Science) will receive \$1,200 while attending, and \$1,200 upon directly transferring to an ABET accredited B.S. engineering discipline.
6. When the successful applicant has been certified by the Dean of the School of Engineering at respective schools as matriculated for the fall semester following high school graduation, The ESB will present the winners the sum of \$300.00 at the Past President's Scholarship Dinner (date TBD). A like sum will be sent to the winner upon similar certification at the beginning of successive semesters.
