Erie County Executive Mark Poloncarz announced a state of emergency this morning in response to the coronavirus pandemic. All schools in Erie County will be closed on Monday, March 16, 2020.

The Clarence Central School District will be closed until further notice. We will reevaluate the length of the closure as more information becomes available.

The County Executive noted in his press conference that an adult in their mid-30s who lives in Clarence has tested positive for coronavirus. The Department of Health has not notified the Clarence School District regarding the positive test.

Erie County superintendents will meet with the Department of Health and the County Executive this afternoon at 4:00 pm. Further information on the closing of schools will be shared later this evening.
