BACK TO SCHOOL INFORMATION

FACE COVERINGS

- Masks will be required for students and staff inside school buildings.
- Masks may be removed when outside as well as during lunch.
- Mask breaks will continue to be scheduled.
- Gaiters, bandanas, and clear face shields are not considered acceptable face coverings.

Seating Charts

- Seating charts are required for all classrooms
- Students are expected to sit in their designated seating areas for their scheduled classes and study halls.
- QR codes and google form to create a daily seating chart in the Cafeteria, Library, and LAC.



Arrival and Dismissal

Arrival:

- Temperatures screened as students enter the building.
- Students arriving between 8:00 a.m. - 8:40 a.m. - report to the library.
- At 8:40 a.m. - students will be excused from the library to go to their locker and then immediately to their first-period class.

Dismissal:

- Dismissal is 3:30 p.m.
- Bus riders must exit the rear of the building
- Walkers or parent pick-ups can take place in the front circle and the Gunnville side of the building.
- Students must exit the building by 3:45 pm (unless participating in extracurricular activities)
- Late buses = 4:30 pm

Chromebooks

- Chromebook Distribution and Pick-Up will be the library
- Dates and Times: Wednesday 9/8, Thursday 9/9, and Friday, 9/10 - 8:00 am - 3:30 pm



Lockers

- Assigned during the first week of school (please bring a lock with you the first day).
- No "sharing" of lockers.
- Lockers should only be used to store school supplies
- When visiting lockers, students **MUST** wear a mask the entire time.
- During lunch and study hall, locker visitation will be limited

Dropping Items Off

- Items being dropped off should only be essential academic items (for example - musical instruments, computers, or prescription medication).
- Please refrain from bringing non-essential items to the building.

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BACK TO SCHOOL INFORMATION



Below are some reminders as you get set to send your students back to school:

- **Masks** – Masks will be required for students and staff inside school buildings. Masks may be removed when outside as well as during lunch. Mask breaks will continue to be scheduled.
- **Seating Charts** - To assist with contact tracing we are required to maintain seating charts for all locations including the Cafeteria, Library, LAC, and Study Hall. Students are expected to sit in their designated seating areas for their scheduled classes and study halls. We will use a QR code and google form to create a daily seating chart in the Cafeteria, Library, and LAC.
- **Arrival** – Students will have their temperatures screened as they enter the building. Students that arrive between 8:00 a.m. - 8:40 a.m. must report to the library. Beginning at 8:40 a.m. students will be excused from the library to go to their locker and then immediately to their first-period class. Students arriving after 8:40 a.m. should proceed to their locker then directly to their first-period classroom.
- **Dismissal** for all students is 3:30 p.m. Any students returning home on a bus must exit the rear of the building while walkers or parent pick-ups can take place in the front circle and the Gunnville side of the building. Students who are not participating in extracurricular activities must exit the building by 3:45 pm. Late buses are available at 4:30 pm for students needing transportation from after-school activities.
- **Chromebooks** - The library will be Chromebook Distribution and Pick-Up location. Students should report to the library to get their devices on the dates and times listed below: Dates and Times for student pick up: Wednesday 9/8, Thursday 9/9, and Friday, 9/10 – 8:00 am – 3:30 pm
- **Lockers** will be assigned during the first week of school (please bring a lock with you the first day). Students can only store their belongings in the locker issued to them. There will be no “sharing” of lockers. Lockers should only be used to store school supplies that will enhance the student’s ability to learn. When visiting lockers, students MUST wear a mask the entire time. During lunch and study hall, locker visitation will be limited and determined by supervising staff.
- **Dropping Items Off** – This should be limited to essential academic items needed for the school day (for example - a musical instrument, computer, or prescription medication). Please refrain from bringing non-essential items to the building.
