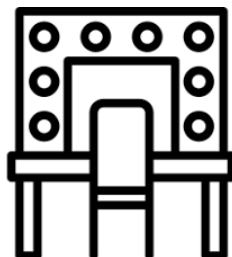
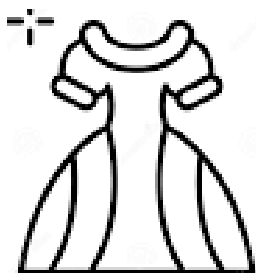

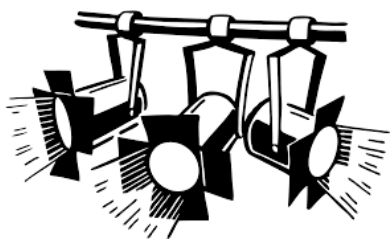
Clara Boglioli

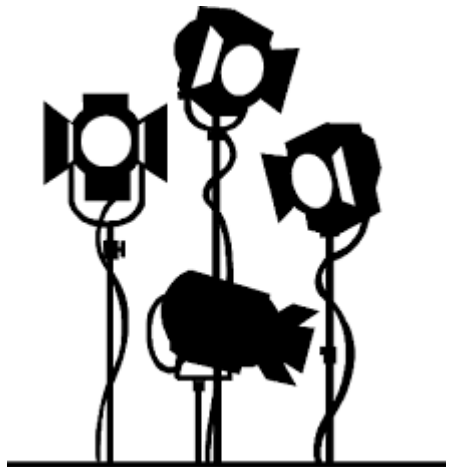
Ryen Nazzaro

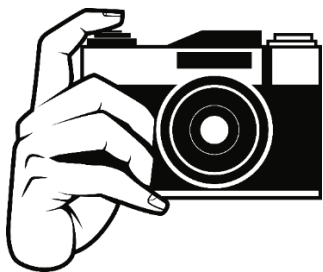

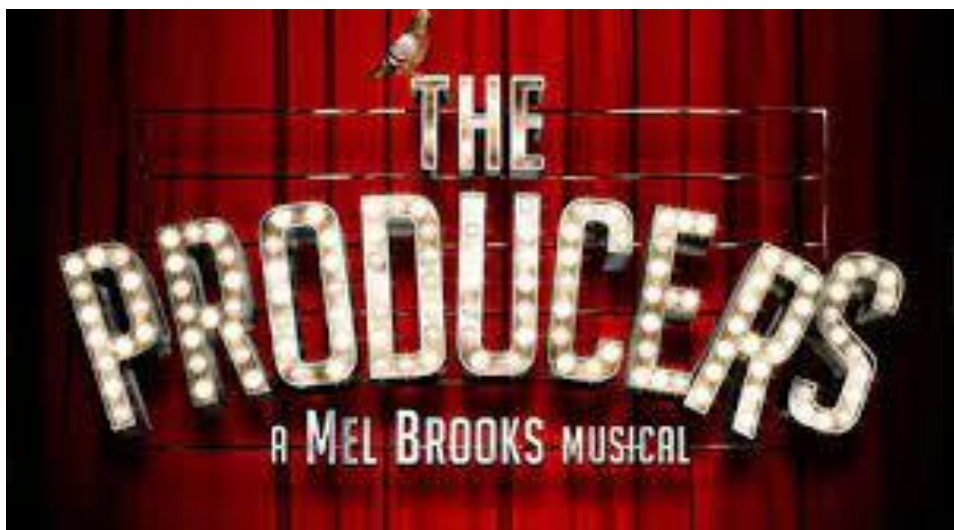
