


Director's Note

Legendary Broadway producer, director & creator/writer of The Producers (1967 film, Broadway musical, 2005 film), Mel Brooks, has spent most of his adult life dealing with and/or fighting antisemitism. As he served in the United States Army deactivating land mines in the European theater during World War II, Brooks recalls fellow American soldiers saying to him on numerous occasions "Jewboy! Out of my way, out of my face, Jewboy!"These experiences, especially while putting his life on the line fighting for his country while the Holocaust was happening in full force, fostered an extremely deep-seated anger at antisemitism. He often asked himself "What's so wrong? What's the matter with being a Jew?" How did Brooks deal with this anger? Comedy and Satire.

One antisemite Brooks has been trying to target his entire adult life is Adolf Hitler. Brooks asked former CBS journalist Mike Wallace during a 60 Minutes interview "How do you get even with such a monster?" Brooks' answer to his own question may be surprising to some "You have to bring him down with ridicule, because if you stand on a soapbox and you match him with rhetoric, you're just as bad as he is, but if you can make people laugh at him, then you are one up on him. It's been one of my lifelong jobs – to make people laugh at Adolf Hitler."

It is a well-know reality that there has been a steady rise in the number of hateful incidents directed at Jewish people worldwide over the past several years. According to the Anti-Defamation League, 2021 and 2022 were the highest years on record for antisemitic incidents here in the United States. The production staff of the Clarence High School Drama Club, by staging Brooks' record setting Tony Award winning musical, The Producers, is hoping to bring light to this deplorable and unacceptable behavior. We ask every audience member to realize Brooks' lifelong mission by enjoying the satire and comedy you will witness on stage. AND, most importantly, LAUGH loud and hard!





David Brophy

Ryan Davidson (12)


Ryan is a Senior at Clarence High School and is overcome with excitement to perform this years musical, The Producers.


Jonathan Swannie (12)
