Concert Etiquette

Please follow these guidelines
for appropriate concert behavior:

1. Arrive on time.

If you are late, please wait until the end of the selection before entering the hall so that latecomers trying to find a seat will not distract the performers and other audience members.

2. Listen quietly while the performance is taking place.

Performers and audience members should never be distracted by unnecessary talking and movement.

3. Applause at the end of a performance.

Applause should be used only at the completion of a piece of music and that is generally indicated when the conductor's arms are dropped to the side.

4. Please do not wave or call out to performers.

Students have worked hard for weeks to prepare for performances. Please do not distract them with improper concert behavior. Applause, as noted above, is the best way to thank the performers.

5. Stay for the entire performance and wait until the end of the selection to leave.

If there is an emergency and you must leave before the final performance, please wait until there is a break in the program.

Douglas Shaw is a native of Western New York and is currently in his twenty-seventh year as the Director of the Clarence High School Symphony, Concert and Chamber Orchestras. He holds a bachelor's degree in marketing from Penn State University and a bachelor's and master's degree in music education from SUNY at Buffalo.

Mr. Shaw is the cellist of the Oakgrove Quartet, which has played in Bermuda and Yellowstone National Park in addition to frequent appearances around Western New York. Mr. Shaw is a member of the Erie County Music Educators Association, New York State School Music Association, and Music Educators National Conference. He has performed with the Buffalo Philharmonic, Western New York Chamber Orchestra, Amherst and Cheektowaga Symphonies, Johnny Mathis, Sarah Brightman, and the classic rock band, The Who.

He has been Chairman of Erie County High School Orchestra for many years and has conducted the Niagara County Junior High and Erie County Elementary and Jr. High Orchestras. He also served as manager and librarian for the Greater Buffalo Youth Orchestra and house manager for the Buffalo Philharmonic.

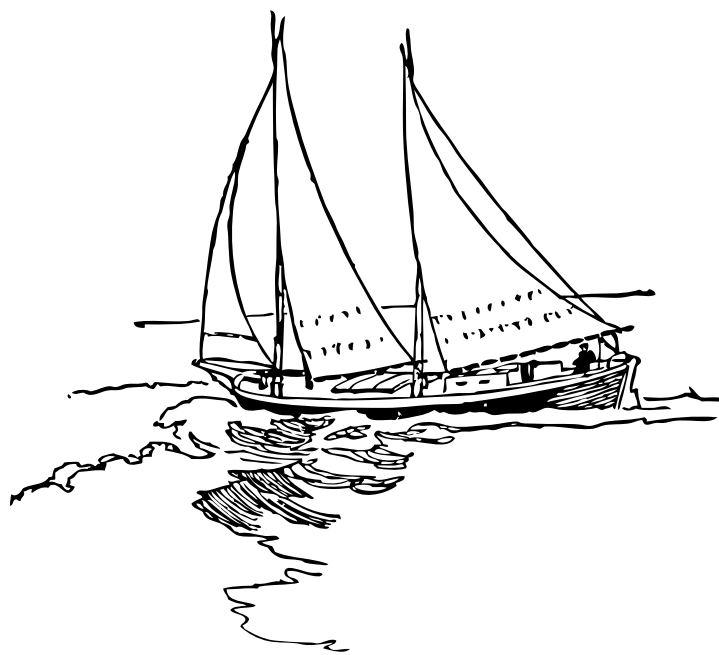
